



# Australian Masters Squash Championships Sydney 2023 Conditions of Entry



## CONDITONS OF ENTRY

1. The 2023 Australian Masters Squash Association Incorporated (AMSA) Individual Championships are open to all Australian and overseas players 35 years and over, who are current financial members of a registered Masters Squash Association in a state/territory/country.
2. Competitors must have attained a minimum age of 35 years by Monday 04/09/2023 for the Individual Championships and by Monday 11/09/2023 for the Interstate Teams Series.
3. Entries for the Individual Championships must be made on the official entry form and must be accompanied by the \$70 entry fee to arrive at NSW Masters Association Australian tournament control no later than Monday 07/08/2023.
4. Interstate Teams Series entry forms must be completed by State Associations and forwarded to the Interstate Teams Series Coordinator by Monday 14/08/2023.
5. All matches will be best of five games played to par 11 for the open age groups 35/40/45/50/55/60/and 65 and par 15 for open age groups 70/75/80/85/and 90+ and for all graded teams under the International Rules of the World Squash Federation.
6. Dunlop Revelation Pro Balls XX [double yellow dot] will be used for all Divisions except where in the lower age Divisions or where players agree to use a single dot ball. In the event of any disagreement on the use of balls, the Tournament Director will be the final arbiter.
- 7. All players will be required to report to the Tournament Control Desk at least 30 minutes before their match.**
8. All players will be expected to be warmed up and ready for hit-up as soon as the previous match is completed.
9. All players will be required to mark and referee the match as directed by the Tournament Control
10. All entries received will be acknowledged by email or phone call. The Draw will be posted on the Tournament website no later than Monday 21/08/2023 ([www.amsc.australianmasterssquash.com.au/2023-home](http://www.amsc.australianmasterssquash.com.au/2023-home))
11. Any notice of withdrawal and request for a refund must be made in writing and received by the Tournament Director by Monday 14/08/2023. No refunds will be made after this date.
12. Any disputes during the Championships must be referred to the Tournament Director.
13. The Individual Championships will be conducted on a Triple Plate or Round Robin basis depending upon the number of entries per event. Every effort will be made to ensure that each entrant gets at least three matches.
14. Forfeits will count as matches.
15. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to accept, decline or re-grade any entries or combine any events where insufficient entries are received.
16. All entries received must be accompanied with full payment and a completed Entry Form.
17. No claims whatsoever will be recognised should any player receive an injury during the Championships.
18. A player who has a predetermined illness and is having ongoing treatment must provide medical evidence before the player will be able to participate in the tournament.
19. The Championships will be conducted in accordance with the Covid plans of the State Government
20. A "NO SMOKING" policy will be strictly enforced within the Squash Centres.
